

Scholarship
&
Bursary Scheme





Greenwich School of Management (GSM) recognises the advantage of enrolling students of high academic calibre: it enhances the reputation of the School and sets high standards for other students to aspire to. Moreover, GSM recognises the financial hardship of some aspiring scholars. Thus, under the mission of the GSM Scholarship and Bursary Committee and subject to the Terms and Conditions stated herein, GSM is offering a range of scholarships and bursaries to new GSM applicants.

Detailed right are the scholarships and bursaries available, the terms and conditions that apply to them and an application form for them:

Scholarships

There are currently two scholarships on offer under this Scheme:

1. The Lord Harris of Greenwich Scholarship (LHG Scholarship)

Award: All the tuition fees for the course applied and accepted for

The late Lord Harris of Greenwich was Patron to GSM from 1990 to 2001 and this scholarship is dedicated to his memory.

The LHG Scholarship will be awarded to those students whose prior qualifications, experience and life achievements have been, to the point of making the application for the scholarship, outstanding. The GSM Scholarship and Bursary Committee has agreed to consider one full scholarship in this category each calendar year and all tuition fees for the GSM course applied for will be covered by the award. The Committee will consider all LHG scholarship applications related to any programme at GSM subject to the Terms and Conditions of the GSM Scholarship and Bursary Scheme stated herein. Please refer to the GSM Scholarship and Bursary Application Form attached hereto.

2. The Alan Kemp Scholarship (AK Scholarship)

Award: 50% of the tuition fees for the course applied and accepted for

Dr Alan Kemp is the current chair of the GSM Council and the Alan Kemp Scholarship is similar to the Lord Harris of Greenwich Scholarship in so far as applications for this scholarship will also be considered on grounds of the prior qualifications, experience and life achievements of the student at the point of making the application. The GSM Scholarship and Bursary Committee has agreed to consider one AK scholarship in this category each calendar year and 50% of the successful applicant's tuition fees for the course applied for will be covered by the award.

The AK Scholarship is for those applications, in a particular calendar year, that are close to achieving LHG Scholarship but have not been awarded it, or in those situations where a LHG Scholarship has already been awarded in that year.

The Committee will consider all AK scholarship applications related to any programme at GSM subject to the Terms and Conditions of the GSM Bursary and Scholarship Scheme stated herein. Please refer to the GSM Scholarship and Bursary Application form attached hereto.



Bursaries

There are currently three categories of bursaries available at GSM:

1. The Principal's Bursaries

Award: A variable award for the course applied and accepted for from non-EU students

The Principal's bursaries are available to non-EU students who have achieved, prior to their application, a good academic standard reflected in their existing qualifications, but are experiencing financial hardship to some degree. Applicants for this award will be expected to demonstrate such financial hardship and the amount of the bursary is variable depending on the existing qualifications of the applicant and the degree of their financial hardship. For example, the bursary could be between 5% and 100% of tuition fees due for part or the whole of the chosen programme.

Currently there are no restrictions to the number of Principal's bursaries that can be awarded in any one particular year. Subject to the Terms and Conditions of the GSM Scholarship and Bursary Scheme stated herein, the GSM Scholarship and Bursary Committee will consider each application on its merits.

2. The Nelson Bursaries

Award: A variable award for serving or retired members of the British armed services

Greenwich is famous for its maritime history and no figure is more famous, in terms of naval history, than The Most Noble Lord Horatio Nelson (1758-1805), Vice-Admiral of the Fleet: quintessentially the Englishman's military hero. Indeed, the lecture rooms at GSM are named after his daring naval exploits. The Nelson Bursaries are, as would be expected, directed at serving or retired members of the British armed forces who wish to pursue a programme of studies at GSM. Like the Principal's Bursaries the award is variable depending upon prior qualifications and service in Her Majesty's armed forces.

There are currently no restrictions to the number of Nelson bursaries that can be awarded in any one particular year. Subject to the Terms and Conditions of the GSM Bursary and Scholarship Scheme stated herein, the GSM Scholarship and Bursary Committee will consider each application on its merits.

3. The Educationist's Bursaries

Award: A variable award for professional educationists from around the world

To reflect GSM's membership of the global educational community, bursaries for serving educationists, home and overseas, are available. Like all the GSM scholarships and bursaries, the award will be based upon prior educational achievement evidenced by the existing qualifications of the applicant. This bursary is open to all educationists whether school teachers or university academics and, like a Principal's Bursary, the award is variable depending upon prior qualifications and service in the education profession.

There are currently no restrictions to the number of educationist bursaries that can be awarded in any one particular year. Subject to the Terms and Conditions of the GSM Scholarship and Bursary Scheme stated herein, the GSM Scholarship and Bursary Committee will consider each application on its merits.

8. Names and positions stated in the titles of the Scheme do not imply any personal liability or responsibility whatsoever
9. The Award is only valid if given in writing and personally signed by the GSM Director of Admissions on GSM headed paper
10. The Award offer is only valid for the course/programme stated on the offer letter and cannot be transferred to alternative programmes or to different periods of study than those applied for without the prior written agreement of GSM for which it is not obligated to give
11. The Award offer only applies to GSM courses/programmes
