The Bachelor of Science (BSc Hons) degree programme in Accounting and Finance at Greenwich School of Management is available to study as an accelerated degree over two calendar years. The BSc (Hons) Accounting and Finance programme is studied in three stages and affords students the opportunity to gain an in-depth understanding of accounting and finance and the pivotal importance that is attached to accurate financial reporting and accounting practices in the business context.

Through the various stages of the BSc (Hons) Accounting & Finance degree programme, students will be introduced to numerous aspects of financial accounting, whether it is corporate financial management or management accounting. Graduates will be suitably proficient in accounting practices with the opportunity to progress to the professional level, eg. ACCA or CIMA. Students on all BSc (Hons) Programmes at GSM will be required to complete an independent project based assignment, allowing them to carry out research in a specific area of study related to their chosen pathway.
