

# BSc (Hons) Computer Science with Business Informatics

The Bachelor of Science (BSc Hons) degree programme in Computer Science with Business Informatics is available to study at Greenwich School of Management as an accelerated degree over two calendar years. This BSc (Hons) Computer Science pathway is studied in three stages and offers students the opportunity to gain a detailed understanding of the technological aspects underpinning computer applications and software engineering. Moreover, throughout the course students will learn to appreciate how the study and implementation of computer science impacts on the wider business environment.

In addition to completing the taught module requirements, students will be required to successfully complete an independent research project on an area relating to their chosen pathway.
