

# BSc (Hons) Human Resource Management with Information Systems

The Bachelor of Science (BSc Hons) Human Resource Management with Information Systems degree programme is available to study at Greenwich School of management as an accelerated degree over two calendar years. This BSc (Hons) HR Management pathway is studied in three stages and offers students the opportunity to develop an appreciation of Human Resource Management and how management information systems assist in this process.

Many organisations are seeking qualified graduates with a background in Human Resource Management, who understand the inter-relationship between the functions of HR and the application of information systems. Successful graduates of this degree will be in a unique position to meet the demands and skills required to develop strategies in order to facilitate the HR needs of the organisation.

In addition to undertaking the taught modules of the programme, students will be required to successfully complete an independent research project on an area relating to their chosen pathway.
