

BSc (Hons) Management with Human Resource Management

The BSc (Hons) Management with Human Resource Management degree programme is available to study at Greenwich School of Management as an accelerated degree over two calendar years. This BSc (Hons) Management pathway is studied in three stages and offers students an essential grounding in the knowledge and skills required to operate at a managerial level within industry. This particular pathway offers the foundation elements of a management programme whilst giving a comprehensive overview of the major issues surrounding the changing role of HRM in the workplace.

In addition to undertaking the taught modules of the programme, students will be required to successfully complete an independent research project on an area relating to their chosen pathway.
